Role Purpose:

You will be responsible for working in close collaboration with academic colleagues within the wider Institute of Health team to help deliver Paramedic and Medical Imaging teaching and learning activities.

The main areas of support will be for our Paramedic and Medical Imaging Science programmes and associated activities. You will be responsible for the running of the clinical skills and medical imaging laboratories, to include equipment calibration, setup, and maintenance. The role will also involve helping students develop skills during self-directed study.

The role will require work with staff, students and external users of programme related equipment.
